entered into Contract no 51/CCWPD/2009 for continuous supervision of the production of wood-based panels in the scope of formaldehyde emission.

Institute carried out independent external control encompassing operation of the Company's quality control system, operation of the Company's laboratory for product quality control, and correctness of tests for formaldehyde emission from/content in the produced wood-based panels conducted within the scope of internal control of the factory production.

Based on the obtained results (Test report № 51 /FC/2014 - 3) Institute states that the product under supervision, i.e.

Particleboard (PB), unfaced

compliant with PN-EN 312 standard, type P2 thickness 12 mm to 32 mm

glued with amine-formaldehyde glue

fulfills the requirements of CARB in the scope of formaldehyde emission envisaged for **Phase 2** set forth in document § 93120.2 (Table 1) provided that the provisions of the effective Contract № 51/CCWPD/2009 are observed.

This Certificate replaces the Certificate № 134/2009-TPC-19 and is valid throughout the whole period of continuous supervision conducted by Instytut Technologii Drewna in the mode of quarterly external controls at the Company.
